The project provided **guidance** throughout the entire process, including finding contractors and making decisions about energy retrofits. **Energy audits** were provided for free and organizations were encouraged to finance the retrofits with a **low-interest loan**.








Fairbanks Nonprofit Retrofit Project Pilot Project Results





12 nonprofits and tribal organizations received energy audits



1 nonprofit financed the energy retrofit with a low-interest loan



8 organizations have begun the energy retrofit process

4 organizations plan to start retrofits in 2016
