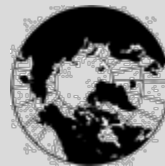




# Fairbanks Nonprofit Retrofit Project Goals & Partners



In 2014, a group of nonprofit and tribal organizations in the Fairbanks area enrolled in a pilot program to increase energy efficiency in their buildings, freeing up money for their missions.



The program is a collaboration among several stakeholders interested in lowering energy costs for organizations that need it most.

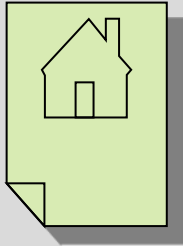
## Pilot Project Activities



The project provided **guidance** throughout the entire process, including finding contractors and making decisions about energy retrofits. **Energy audits** were provided for free and organizations were encouraged to finance the retrofits with a **low-interest loan**.



# Fairbanks Nonprofit Retrofit Project Pilot Project Results



**12** nonprofits and tribal organizations received energy audits



**1** nonprofit financed the energy retrofit with a low-interest loan



**8** organizations have begun the energy retrofit process  
**4** organizations plan to start retrofits in 2016
